It is important that your organisation has completed a risk assessment to decide whether a 3 day first aid at work workshop is required at a qualified first aider level or a one day appointed person HSE approved workshop.

This is a Health & Safety approved centre workshop where the assessment is in the form of continuous assessment and oral questioning.

- Have an understanding of the priorities of First Aid
- Develop techniques for simple record keeping and documentation.
- Gain knowledge regarding the treatment of shock, unconscious casualties, bleeding, burns and scalds.
- Gain a knowledge of resuscitation practice
- Have an overview of the appropriate treatment of injuries to bones and joints
- Gain knowledge of and maintain the contents of an approved first aid box.
- Have an understanding of and be able to demonstrate the recovery position
- Be aware of the treatment for asphyxia and choking
- Be aware of the treatments for Hypothermia and heat Exhaustion
